Your Will is an important legal document. It recognises loved-ones and reflects the values and causes closest to your heart; family, church and community.

Your gift

The Eternal Guardians Program

When you confirm your intention to leave a gift in your Will, you become a member of our Eternal Guardians Program. Created specifically to honour all those who remember the Church in their Will, this program is a celebration of your commitment to the future of our faith.

As an Eternal Guardian, you will be invited to receive a special blessing from the Archbishop of Brisbane at a Thanksgiving Mass and you will be presented with a Certificate of Appreciation and a special lapel pin.

Recommended clause for leaving a gift in your Will to your Parish
