### Rite of Blessing and Sprinkling of Water

Presider: Dear brothers and sisters,  
let us humbly ask the Lord our God  
to bless this water he has created,  
which will be sprinkled on us  
as a memorial of our Baptism.  
May he help us by his grace  
to remain faithful to the Spirit we have received.


*Silence...*

Lord our God,  
in your mercy be present to your people's prayers,  
and, for us who recall the wondrous work of our creation  
and the still greater work of our redemption,  
graciously + bless this water.  
For you created water to make the fields fruitful  
and to refresh and cleanse our bodies.  
You also made the water the instrument of your mercy:  
for through water you freed your people from slavery  
and quenched their thirst in the desert;  
through water the Prophets proclaimed the new covenant  
you were to enter upon with the human race;  
and last of all,  
through water, which Christ made holy in the Jordan,  
you have renewed our corrupted nature  
in the bath of regeneration.  
Therefore, may this water be for us  
a memorial of the Baptism we have received,  
and grant that we may share  
in the gladness of our brothers and sisters  
who at Easter have received their Baptism.

### **Profession of Faith**

Reader: For those called to leadership in our church: may the Spirit of integrity and wisdom guide them in their service to their sisters and brothers...let us pray to the Lord...

**All: Lord hear our prayer.**

Reader: For the United Nations and for all who are dedicated to world peace: may the Spirit's power put an end to division and gather all people in unity... let us pray to the Lord

**All: Lord hear our prayer.**

Reader: For those without adequate housing and health care, education and work: may we act decisively on their behalf in the power of the Spirit...let us pray to the Lord

**All: Lord hear our prayer.**

Reader: For all the newly initiated members of our faith communities who complete today the paschal season of mystagogy: may they be faithful witnesses with us as members of the one Body of Christ...let us pray to the Lord

**All: Lord hear our prayer.**

Reader: For this assembly and all who serve our Holy Spirit community in a variety of ministries: may the Spirit inspire us to use our gifts to enrich the life of our community...let us pray to the Lord

**All: Lord hear our prayer.**

Reader: For all those who have died, especially staff & students of Holy Spirit Seminary, members of our families, friends and benefactors of Holy Spirit Seminary: may they receive the fullness of life promised to all good and faithful servants... let us pray to the Lord

**All: Lord hear our prayer.**

Presider: Loving God,  
you open wide your hand  
and satisfy with your good gifts the needs of all people.  
Pour forth your Holy Spirit on your Church,  
gathered in prayer with the Mother of Jesus,  
and cause springs of living water to well up within it,  
so that all may quench their thirst for justice and truth.

the Holy Spirit may reveal to us more abundantly  
the hidden mystery of this sacrifice  
and graciously lead us into all truth.  
Through Christ our Lord.


**All: Amen.**

#### Holy Holy


Ho - ly, ho - ly, ho - ly Lord God of hosts. Hea - ven and earth are



and pervade them with its purifying light.

**All: Amen.**

Presider: And may God, who has been pleased to unite many tongues  
in the profession of one faith,  
give you perseverance in that same faith and, by believing,  
may you journey from hope to clear vision.

**All: Amen.**

Presider: And may the blessing of almighty God,  
the Father, and the Son + and the Holy Spirit  
come down on you and remain with you forever.

**All: Amen.**

### **Dismissal**

Deacon: Go forth, the Mass is ended, alleluia, alleluia.

**All: Thanks be to God, alleluia, alleluia.**

**Recessional:     *Filled with the Spirit's Power***

Filled with the Spirit's power, with one accord  
the infant Church confessed its risen Lord:  
O Holy Spirit, in the Church today  
no less your power of fellowship display.
